Conference Championship Weekend

It’s Conference Championship Weekend and the NFL’s version of the Final Four. The Green Bay Packers will meet the Chicago Bears in the NFC draw while the New York Jets take on the Pittsburgh Steelers to decide the AFC Champion with the winners moving on to play in Super Bowl XLV on February 6th in Cowboys Stadium. Interesting to note that both top seeds lost last weekend as home field advantage continues to be an overrated handicapping element with hosts now just 10-10 SU the last five years in Divisional Round play. As mentioned last week, home teams are even worse in the Wild Card Round, going 13-15 SU the past seven seasons.

The NFC Championship Game will be unique for several reasons. One is that it is a matchup of division rivals. This is just the seventh time that’s happened since 1984 and only the fourth since 1989 in either conference championship. Road and home teams have split those six previous meetings, going 3-3 SU/ATS. Green Bay has opened as a three-point road favorite over Chicago and that’s unusual too as it’s only the fifth time a visitor has been favored in this round since 1984. Road favorites were 3-0 ATS before Philly lost outright to Arizona in the NFC Title Game two years ago. It should be mentioned that the Bears were 2-0 ATS vs. the Packers during the regular season, including an outright win as three-point home dogs on this field back in Week Three. The rematch in the regular season finale saw the Pack win 10-3 at home as huge double-digit favorites as the Monsters of the

Midway had nothing to play for. Totals players will be interested in knowing that all six meetings between these NFC North rivals the last three seasons have gone Under.

The AFC Championship Game should be a battle of defense with the Jets taking on the Steelers. Pittsburgh has opened as a three-point favorite, playing in its fifth Conference Championship since 2001 (2-2 SU and ATS) and eighth since 1994 (3-4 SU/2-5 ATS). The Jets are in this game for the second straight year after losing to the Colts last year 30-17 as eight-point underdogs. Remember that they did lead that game outright at halftime. This is also a regular season rematch with the Jets beating the Steelers outright on this field 22-17 as three-point underdogs back in Week 15. Could this be a battle of the two most unappreciated QB’s in the league? Jets QB Mark Sanchez has posted four playoff road wins in two seasons, all over division champs. Steelers QB Ben Roethlisberger is 9-2 SU in playoff games for his career, going 7-3-1 ATS.

Philadelphia at Charlotte Thursday, Jan. 20th, 7:05 ET

For the second straight week, we will play the non-TNT Thursday night game. Last week, we cashed with Minnesota over Washington. Here we will take the Charlotte Bobcats over the Philadelphia 76ers. These teams just met Monday afternoon with the Sixers prevailing 96-92 at home in OT. However, it was the Bobcats that left with the cash as 5.5-point dogs as they led outright by double digits in the third quarter, but were unable to hold on for the SU victory. Charlotte will hope for some better luck on Tuesday when they host the Central Division leading Chicago Bulls. Philadelphia also has a tough test prior to this rematch as they will be at Orlando Wednesday night. Playing on back to back days will be tough for the Sixers, who now lead the Bobcats by 1.5 games for the 8th and final playoff spot in the Eastern Conference. After a 3-13 SU start, 1st year HC Doug Collins has Philly playing some good basketball with a winning SU record since that time, not to mention the best points spread mark in the league at 24-15-1 ATS. That said, the Sixers are on an 0-4 ATS run entering the game with the Magic. Charlotte has also made a coaching change, albeit a more recent one as Larry Brown stepped down after a disappointing 28 game start and in came veteran Paul Silas. We immediately saw an improvement with the Bobcats, whose scoring average has jumped by nearly a full seven points per game under Silas and the team has also cut its turnovers down by three per game. Unfortunately, after winning six of their first eight for their new coach, the team has dropped three straight headed into Tuesday. However, not only will the revenge angle be in play here, but so will the home court. **5* on Charlotte**

Where to even begin? For starters, they have not won a game in regulation since November, losing 22 of 23 overall with only an OT win over the Knicks, who were in the second game of back-to-backs. It all goes back to December 2nd when LeBron James returned to town, broke the fans hearts again and crippled the franchise for good. The Cavs are now the worst point-spread team in the league as well at 13-25-2 ATS. During the losing streak, they are 5-18 ATS! They were double-digit dogs in three of those ATS wins. On Wednesday, they will finally return home after a disastrous road swing that saw them lose four times by 18 points or more, including a flat out embarrassing 112-57 loss to the Lakers last Tuesday. Any time you can step in against the Cavs and get some value, you have to do it. These opportunities will be few and far between. Since they will be playing at home Friday night against the division rival Milwaukee Bucks, who are just 14-24 SU and losers of three straight, we have one such opportunity. This will actually be a revenge game for the Bucks, who lost to the Cavs here in Cleveland 83-81 as 1.5-point favorites back on November 24th. Memphis at Milwaukee Saturday, Jan. 22nd, 8:35 ET

We'll now turnaround and "buck" Milwaukee the following night when they have a quick turnaround and must host the up and coming Memphis Grizzlies, who are 7-1 ATS this season when facing a team playing the second game of back to backs this season. As mentioned in the Cavs writeup, Milwaukee is really struggling right now with three straight losses and dropping 11 of 15 overall. They fell Monday afternoon in Houston as the offense again failed defensive-minded HC Scott Skiles. The Bucks currently rank dead last in the NBA in scoring at just 91 points per game. That's two full points worse than the next team (Charlotte). Memphis started the week with a home loss to Chicago, the first time they'd lost on their own floor in five games there. Although the Grizzlies are not nearly as polished on the road, they did beat the Lakers 105-84 away earlier in the year. This also kicks off a crucial four-game road swing against Eastern Conference teams, all losing opponents. It's is a double revenge spot for Memphis, who lost both meetings with Milwaukee last season, both only by a five-point margin. **3* on Memphis**

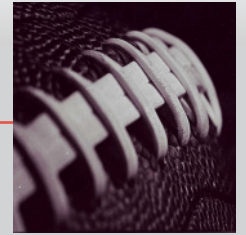
New York at Houston
